

Recently the church campus experienced a Saturday night power outage. We arrived Sunday morning to find that the internet was not operating, which also meant that the air conditioners, which are connected to our internet-based network servers, were not operating either.

With 1,000+ people expected later in the morning, we began to manually turn on air conditioners, identify alternative mechanisms for children's check-in, and ensure backup recordings of the service were made for our livestream audience.

It is amazing how dependent we have become on electrical power. When the power goes out, we lose nearly all modern conveniences (good thing many toilets don't depend on electrical power—yet!).

Have you ever sensed that you aren't operating fully under the Spirit's power? From time to time, we may feel like our spiritual power has been turned off.

In the Book of Ephesians, Paul, on his knees, is praying for the people of Ephesus. He is praying that they would be "strengthened with power," that as a church they "May have power, together with all the Lord's people," and that they be reminded "God's power is at work in us."

One of the ways we can ensure that our church's spiritual power is on is through prayer. As you think about how you might pray for our church—pray that each of us would be plugged into the Spirit's power—a power that helps us understand the deep, wide, and vast love of God, a power that can do beyond anything we can ask or imagine. Let's pray that God's power operates at full strength in our lives.







Ladies of all ages and stages are invited to come hang out and share life on the third Thursday of each month at 9AM in the Cafe.


WORSHIP MINISTRY

How do you respond when someone asks you for help?


This is the challenge and opportunity at the heart of Neighbor 2 Neighbor (N2N) Ministry at Pioneer Drive. N2N seeks to connect our church with our community with trained volunteers following up with requests for financial assistance.



"When I make a call to a neighbor in need, I do not know the reception or details of the need from the person who has requested our church's help. In each situation, finding out the needs, some personal information about the family such as age of children, where they go to school or day care and if there is other family support, has allowed the person to open and share more prayer needs than the initial financial request.

This is an opportunity to chat, pray and contact them back along with considering their financial requests. I prayed for one couple to have access to the Presbyterian Medical Mission Services where they had been on the waiting list for weeks in addition to the need for utility payment assistance. When I called them back the next day, they told me two-hours after we prayed together on the phone they received a call from Medical Missions, and an appointment was scheduled for the following Monday to receive assistance with their health issues. This was a blessing for all—for them and for me to see God at work and fast—because God knew their needs!

Sometimes I have talked to a believer and other times to someone who I am praying for to feel the love and care of Jesus and will want to know more. Each call and contact have been a blessing to me as the Lord works in our community."

- After introductions ask, "What led you to Pioneer?"
- Remind them the number for our local Call for Help Center is 325-673-8211, where they can learn about any resources in the area.
- Offer them a refreshment. Ask our staff about Welcome Boxes.
- Invite them to pray with you or join you for worship or class.
- They can always leave a name and number on our main church line, and we will follow up ASAP.
